After much prayer, the Lord provided the needed chopper, through an oil company, to transport her to the coast to the hospital and doctor who performed a c-section. The rain and wind settled at just the right time for the chopper to land and depart. We had witnessed to Yaniamo and prayed for her salvation, hoping her life would be spared so she would have a chance for the Holy Spirit to work in her heart and that she would receive the gift of salvation by grace through faith. Several months later, she made the journey back up into the mountains and stopped by the clinic. We had recently left for furlough, but the team still there treated her infection and shared with us the good news that she had accepted Christ's salvation. Please pray for Yaniamo's growth and discipleship, as she lives far from our church and is in a difficult family situation, in a village filled with spiritism and fear.

Not only is God working in Papua New Guinea, but here in the United States as well. God has blessed as Sam has preached in many

churches. Although we don't know all of the results, we have seen some respond to the Lord's working and also heard about a visitor at one church who was talking with church staff about salvation after the service.

You, dear supporters, have had a part in reaching these two souls. We are glad to have met with many of you this furlough. We have traveled to churches in Ohio, Indiana, West Virginia, Maryland, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Virginia, Alabama, and Tennessee. Although we have kept busy traveling thousands of miles, many of the pastors and members of the congregations have taken good care of us. Thank you for your prayers for our continued safety in travel.
