We have had two new men since our last letter. One was a new Chad and unfortunately Chad had to leave us after just a few weeks. Last week Curtis came to join us and we are looking forward to God working in his life. I also have Beau coming on this coming Friday.

The Chad who has been with us for the past four months is still here. The court has allowed us to keep Chad for another 45 days. This is a great blessing because he would have spent that 45 days in jail and he can do that time here with us. Jimmy is leaving next week to pursue a career in auto mechanics. He has been offered an opportunity through NAPA Auto parts and Whetzel's Automotive where he will work in Columbia, SC. They will provide a place to live, a car and work him there in their shop and train him. He will be leaving on Tuesday to move to Columbia. God has done much for these two men.

Brian was able to get George a job with him on a Construction job in Charleston, SC.

Our building project is progressing, of course I said in our last letter that the electrical is complete. We are now waiting on the HVAC crew to come do their rough in work. Hopefully in the next few weeks we can have that part done, and then comes the mechanical inspection. When we pass this inspection, we can put in the insulation and sheetrock that we have setting in the building. We have \$1000 toward the paint needed in the building, we need another \$3500 to finish paying for the paint. A Church in Tampa, FL has promised to purchase all the toilets and shower facets. Things are coming together and we are expecting GREAT THINGS in the future with more capacity to help men.

Did you know that statistics say that 93% of families receive Christ if the Husband is saved first, where only 17% of families receive Christ when the wife is saved first and only 3.5% of families get saved when a child receives Christ first. We are trying to reach men with the Gospel and the end result is families will be reached. If we have more jobs in our country, who will fill them.
