Dear Co-Laborers in the Gospel,

We trust that you all had a joyous Christmas and great start to the New Year. We had the privilege of doing a chronological reading of passages of Scripture related to Christ's birth with our daughter and son-in-law, Deborah and Israel and their family and had dinner with our daughter Sarah, Eric and family and were privileged to talk with Stephen and Miriam by phone. The year came to a close with an encouraging call from Stephen about a Bible passage, another Bible study with Carlos and two emails from believers in Panama—one who recently got right with the Lord and wanted to make sure that everything was well between us. What an end to the old and start of the new!

Our hearts are daily challenged to intensify our evangelistic outreach. The Lord has opened many doors to do so both in English and Spanish. Recently when shopping, the Lord gave us the privilege of speaking to six Hispanic couples and giving them gospel literature. Another day we spoke to an Hispanic man who studies with the Jehovah's Witnesses. He refused gospel literature but did allow us to talk to him and even asked for a Bible reference to back what we shared. Our hearts go out to such who have been blinded by religion. Also, our neighbors, Noris and Sherry, have gone from refusal to hear the gospel to allowing us to pray with them and talk to them about spiritual things. They are beginning to read the Bible. This has been over a period of years.

Would you please partner with us in our ministry to Carlos? He is saved but is plagued by a horrible past! He is daily confronted with temptation to fall back. Our most recent Bible studies have been so encouraging. We are dealing with the need for a meaningful prayer time and study of Scripture daily and are walking him through passages to help him develop a true worship time in his daily life. The distance to his house in NC is an hour round trip (twice a week). The Lord has opened the door for him to work with a believer which will be of great help to him spiritually.

Recently the Lord burdened our hearts to reach out to churches and individuals to help them do more to reach Hispanics with the Gospel. Any pastors and churches who are interested in doing more or starting to do something to reach Hispanics, can receive help in so doing.
