Dear Supporters and Praying Friends,

I pray this letter finds you all doing well. I can't believe we are now living in 2020. I want to start by saying THANK YOU to each one for all you have done for us over the past 10 years. March 1, 2010 we picked up our first man. His Name was Chris. God has done so much for Fair Haven in the past 10 years of helping men. We have had 115 men go through our doors in the past 10 years. It is because of your kindness to us.

Darren and Robbie both graduated and are back with their families. Danny is still with us from Atlanta, GA.

Joseph has joined us since our last letter and he will graduate in a few weeks. Joseph is from KY and we were able to get his Birth Certificate, Social Security Card and Drivers license for him. He has been on drugs since he was about 14 years old and he is now 43. Joseph is coming to us through the ministry of Calvary Baptist Temple in East Bernstadt, KY. Tyler Perry came to South Carolina to preach in the 50th Anniversary of Community Baptist Church. Joseph, who was sent here by the church Tyler is out of, got saved while Tyler was preaching. God is working in Joseph's life.

WE PASSED OUR INSPECTION on the building!!!! The building is coming along. Insulation is in the outer walls, HVAC is installed and working. We are now ready for sheetrock to be put in. As you know, the sheetrock was donated to us. Someone came at Christmas and is looking to see if he can get all the carpet for the building. We are hoping and praying.

One of our supporting churches from KY said that they will match any donation that is given to Fair Haven on the building. We need money for sheetrock supplies, such as screws. We had \$1000 donated toward paint, praise the Lord. The estimate for the paint is about \$4,800. We are still praying for the \$3,800 to come in. We also still need money for trim, four shower stalls, a bath tub and a handicap shower stall, cement for walk ways and porches, and tile for the bathrooms and kitchen.

We are getting closer and closer with this project, but we need your help. Again, whatever you donate will be matched by the church in KY. Thank you to each one that has donated just in the past week or so. Ridgeview Baptist in Walland, TN donated \$10,000. Rogerville Baptist Temple donated \$500. Sumter Baptist Temple donated \$5000. We are overjoyed with the response to help us finished this building and help more men with more space.

We appreciate all that the churches and individuals have done for the Facility of Fair Haven Home for Men, Inc. We could not do it without your labor, finances, and prayers. Helping men get on track is what it is all about. Robbie came to us, finished our program, and got his heart right with the Lord. Now Robbie is going home to a 5 year old son, 11 year old daughter, and a wife. Do you think this family thinks this program is worth the effort, time and finances? This 5 year old boy will grow up and say my dad got help at Fair Haven Home for Men and I have not had to go there and my children will not have to go there because my dad got help and came home to be a DAD and take responsibility for our family. IT IS WORTH IT!!!!
