Dear Fellow Laborers in the Gospel,

Our hearts are filled with praise to our great God (Ps. 145:3) as we meditate on all that He is and how wonderfully He works in our lives. Your partnership through prayer and giving is one of the great blessings He has bestowed upon us!

We joyfully share that he has wonderfully answered our UNSPOKEN PRAYER REQUEST. For months we had no peace that we were to stay in the church where we have been members for four years—a good, solid, Bible-preaching church. After attending Westgate Baptist Church for five months, we became convinced that the Lord wanted us there. Just before joining, we were presented with an UNEXPECTED OPPORTUNITY for service. We were asked to consider teaching Spanish 2 in their Christian School. After much prayer and consideration, we agreed to do it, but only on a volunteer basis. The school pays our travel expenses, but we accept no salary. The classes are five days a week from 12:20 p.m. to 1:10 p.m., so our schedule has changed drastically. Lorraine also does tutoring for students who need the extra help. We have been teaching for the past five weeks, and it has been so encouraging to us. The school has children from a number of Hispanic families, and the contact information for these families will be given to us for visitation purposes! We have also learned that there is a much heavier Hispanic population in that area than the area where we were previously members. The pastor has also told us that if the Lord opens the door for a Bible study at church time, we will be provided with a place to have it. This would make it possible for English-speaking Hispanic children to attend the regular Sunday School classes and/or church.

It is with excitement that we share that there are UNLIMITED OPEN DOORS to share the gospel with Hispanics—a family from Honduras in a Denny's restaurant, a Cuban man when we went to have the car serviced at Ford and many Mexican people. Everywhere we go we talk to Hispanics, and they gladly receive gospel tracts. Brothers and sisters in Christ, this "...field is white unto harvest...", and it is right here in our back yards. May God increase our burden and give us courage to give them the only message that can give them hope, Romans 1:16.

Please keep praying for Carlos. We have a Bible study with him on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. He has so much baggage from his past for a young believer, but has asked for help in developing a regular, personal devotional time. We have been walking him through books like Ephesians, I John, etc. and showing him how to discover precious gems and how to apply them to his own life.

PLEASE PRAY for: the salvation of lost souls, upcoming visitation of Hispanic sections of town (one near our home and one near our church), tract distribution, unsaved neighbors, Carlos, helping others to evangelize Hispanics, spiritual growth of believers, wisdom and strength for service, Jonathan's continued progress, and our nation, churches, missionaries as they deal with COVID-19. Thank you for your prayers for us!
