Dear Supporters and Praying Friends,

I pray this letter finds each one of you doing well. These have been crazy times with the Virus and all that comes along with it. Fair Haven Home for Men has taken precautions with our men. We have spent the majority of our time working on the inside of our building. We have installed all the inner wall insulation, blocking, fixing some plumbing issues that needed to be cared for.

I have exceptionally good news we had all the floor tile for our building donated by Mr. Broughton from Dallas, TX. It was delivered this morning. That is a huge blessing. It was about 1350 sq. ft of tile for the bathrooms and kitchen. Mr. Broughton is also working on carpet for the building too. We are still waiting to hear about the carpet. We are praying that it all comes together. The sheetrock men were not able to come due to the Virus, so we are now planning for them to come very soon.

As I wrote in our last letter, we have a church in KY that will match any amount given to the Fair Haven building project. We will be doing this at the first of June. If you give \$500 that would really be \$1000 and \$5000 would really be \$10,000. We are getting a lot done around our building. We have sheetrock crews lined up, painters lined up, and trim carpenters ready to come. The Brandon Baptist Tabernacle is purchasing our plumbing fixtures such as toilets, sinks, and facets for showers. Someone donated \$1000 toward the paint which will be about \$4800 total cost. I am talking to people about light fixtures, electrical fixtures, the rest of plumbing, kitchen equipment, beams for our great room, bunk beds, and cement for the porches. I am on the phone with companies asking for donations, labor, or materials.

We have had Joseph finish the program. He is now looking for a job and housing. The Virus has hindered this also. Brandon came from Hendersonville, NC and finished last Sunday. Stephen came two weeks ago from Inman, SC. I had Vaughn from West Virginia. We have seen some of these men profess Christ as Lord and Saviour. We have seen God working in their lives and changes being made.

Do you know 12% of American children under the age of 18 live with a parent who has abused/been dependent upon alcohol or drugs within the past year? Do you know that 75% of people with an addiction problem are employed. Many that come to our home have jobs and families. What a difference Fair Haven could make for an employer with a good man that has a terrible addiction. Did you know from 1999 to 2017, more than 700,000 Americans died from overdosing on a drug? Did you know alcohol and drug addiction cost the U.S. economy over \$600 billion every year?

Fair Haven can make a difference in one home, one job, one family, one wife, one child and one future.
