This will necessitate a move to Huntsville, AL. Jonathan and his fiancée, Hope, have decided to get married on May 30<sup>th</sup> and rent the house from his parents for the time being. Jonathan continues to make encouraging progress physically, (can even feel his socks on his feet, etc.) but is still unable to walk.
