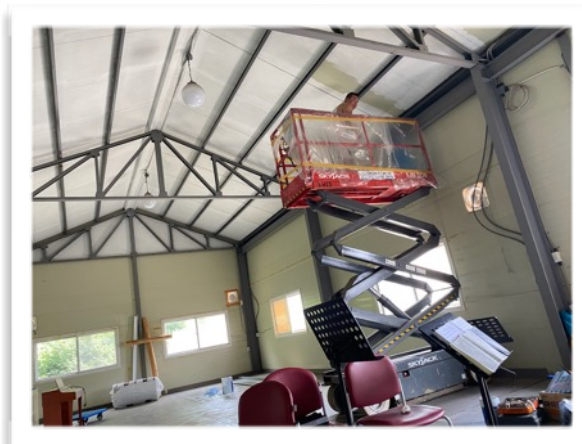

We do not have easy access to carpentry/ renovation materials as you would to a **Home Depot or a Lowe's in the US.**

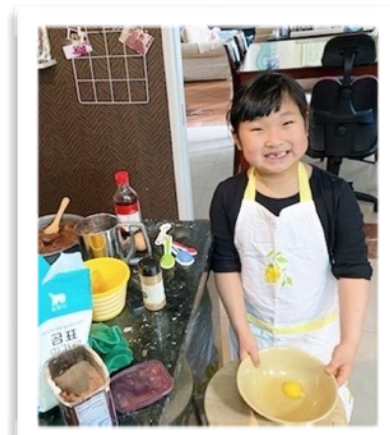
This provides somewhat of a challenge and I would appreciate your prayers! We know **God will provide** these needs as He sees fit!

Lauren (17), Lyndsy (13), Lilyanne (7) are taking a break from school now but begin back in August. All three ladies are growing in the Lord and **seeking opportunities to witness** and disciple. Lauren was able to finish off all her high school credits the past semester, but desires to take more rigorous high school courses for the next two more years to prepare for college studies in medicine.



God has deeply burdened Lauren for the unborn babies that are aborted in horrendous numbers each year here. Korea has **legalized abortion** just last year, increasing teen sexual promiscuity to another level. Lauren greatly desires to raise awareness among Korean teenagers to **God's view of life** which is at conception and not from man's faulty perception. **Please pray for her** as she begins this **vital ministry for teen girls**.
