Dear Fellow Laborers in the Gospel,

Once again we send warm greetings in our Savior's Name and a big THANK YOU for your prayers for our Hispanic outreach as well as your financial support. You are being used in ways that only eternity will show. You are such an encouragement to us!

Many of you have prayed for our son, Stephen, for years. We have seen evidence of God's working in his life for quite some time, but for the past 4-5 months, he has engaged in lengthy telephone conversations with Frank. We wish that we could give more detail, but on March 26, in his semi, he trusted Christ to save him. He did not tell us immediately because he wanted to make sure that it was not just another empty profession. However, we had noted the change in our conversations with him. He is now intensely studying Scripture, asking questions, sharing what he is learning and praising God for answers to prayer. He even told Jonathan that one thing that God used was the way that Jonathan has trusted the Lord in adversity. **What a great God we serve!** Truly, "salvation is of the Lord" Jonah 2:9. To our God alone be all the praise and glory! Your continued prayers are needed for Stephen's spiritual growth. He calls and talks Scripture for an hour or so 3-5 times weekly. May God give me (Frank) the intensity and interest of a newborn babe!



In our last prayer letter, we requested prayer concerning the provision of a "functional electric stimulation bike" for Jonathan. He now has the bike and received it totally without cost! He and Hope are now married, and he continues his exercises and has activity in other parts of his body and better trunk control. Your prayers mean so much!

Our church (Westgate Baptist) is back to all regular services. We are also going to have four backyard VBS ministries over a two-week period. We were privileged to help prepare some items for that ministry. This VBS outreach will be at homes of four different church families.

Our Hispanic outreach continues to be affected by COVID-19, but we are hoping that we can soon get back to normal though things seem to be retrogressing here. Our study with Carlos has not restarted despite our attempts to do so. We still have regular contact by text and are hoping to restart soon. The Lord continues to open some doors in stores, restaurants, etc. We had a great contact when having our car serviced. The Mexican man waiting there with us was very open and read the gospel literature completely in our presence. Another day we were privileged to give gospel literature to a Spanish work crew at a neighbor's home. Let's all increase our efforts to reach lost souls. The coming of the Lord draweth nigh! Also, during this time of the pandemic, we have devoted ourselves to completing numerous work projects around the house.
