I was hoping that because of other denominations choosing not to open their doors, we would see opportunities to reach out to those who normally would be attending those churches. Whether that is the underlying reason or not, I feel like God has been building His church during this time. For starters, the church recently voted to purchase quality stacking chairs because we were at capacity for what we had on hand. We've also seen several new visitors over the past few months, some of which have periodically returned. This has given us even more people with which to follow up, and those meetings have yielded fruit.
