Dear Supporters and Praying Friends,

I pray this letter finds each one of you doing well. We have good news. Sheetrock has been installed in 1/3 of the buildings. Landmark Baptist Church came and installed all we could in three days. They are planning another trip. We are excited to be at this point.

We are also painting the outside of the building. We had received a bill for water and sewer hook up for the building. It was going to be \$60,000. I called the County Supervisor and set up a meeting with him and several others in that department. We met and after several days of worry and frustration, we got the categorization of our building changed to a boarding house. The bill is now \$21,000. This is still a lot of money but it is much better than \$60,000.

We will have a contractor company come in and put the 2" water line and 6" sewer lines from the building to the street which will add to the cost of water and sewer. If any of you feel lead to help in off setting the \$21,000 cost it would be such a blessing. It was not something we had planned on, at least not that much. Some churches have sent in some money to help with this. We are so very thankful to them.

Stephen is doing great; he has a job and works every day. Darren is working a job also. Charles is graduated and working a job. Stephen is new here and he is graduating in about a month. I also have Bradley and he has a few months to go. Please pray for these men. Some will soon be looking for places to live and some will return to their homes. God is working on their hearts and working in their lives. Some of you will remember Brian. Brian got a job with a drafting company and is in training now for that position.

We are back on the road preaching and telling about the home. Covid has really put a damper on things and slowed progress in all areas. Building materials are sometimes hard to find. Even our groceries for the men was a difficult process at times through all this.
