Dear Praying Friends,

The Country & COVID-19: Pray for Ghana as they hold their presidential elections in December. We don't anticipate any kind of violence or rioting, but it is wise to minimize going out in the days following the election. Leading up to the election, there has been some complications regarding voter registration that has put many on edge. Where we are located, Coronavirus has not been all that prevalent or disruptive of late, so we are thankful for that.

The Ministry: Since our last prayer letter we have seen nine profess Christ! Typically, my wife teaches children's Sunday school class while I teach the adults. On Sundays when Melissa is unable to teach, we will combine Sunday school classes. This happened in September, and instead of teaching the lesson from the curriculum that my wife would have taught, I was led to present the gospel. Nine young people responded, and I took each, one-by-one, and explained again God's plan of salvation. Of those nine, seven accepted Christ! We also recently saw two accept Christ while out on visitation.
