This month India began one of the largest vaccination drives in the world with over two million people vaccinated to date. India has recorded almost eleven million COVID cases with daily case counts steadily declining. Delhi has just shown some of the lowest daily case counts in over 9 months with under 100 being reported. Some outlets are beginning to report that the international flight operation ban could lift as soon as February. All this is positive news which we pray is leading to India's soon reopening.
