At this time, we are still unable to leave for language school since the borders to Denmark remain closed. Denmark recently went on a strict nationwide lockdown that is currently in affect until the end of February, We do not know for sure how much longer the border will remain close but we do know that God knew all along that this would happen and that He is still in control. Please continue to pray with us that the Lord's will be done and that the borders will open in His timing.
