The work of the Lord must go on in spite of depraved political crisis. People need the Lord. We experience the hand of God doing amazing things as the Gospel has been shared.

Praise God, it has been over two months that we, as church are able to gather together at church building for worship service every Sunday. Of course many churches cannot have worship service yet due to political situation and third wave of Covid19. We were able to hold five days intensive teaching of the Bible during Buddhist New Year festival in the month of April. It was the first time for six attendees who listened the proclamation of the Word attentively.

Praise God, we witnessed four people following the Lord through water baptism. One of them was my son Nathan. He had been saved for years and finally it is God-privilege to personally baptize him. The other three are siblings and now we meet together once a week for discipleship. Their parents are not saved yet but they come to church regularly. And we are able to share the Gospel regularly at their home. What a joy it is to see regular visitors at church every Sunday.

Praise God, my wife is also able to hold a new women Bible study at our member's home twice a week. Unbelievers also came to Bible study. We are able to bring our members' children twice a week to church and teach them the Bible as they do not go to school. **Praise God**, with your generous relief offering, aids have been given, not only to our members and unbelievers around us, but also to our fellow pastors and believers who are now in a very tough situation due to shooting.

We are now in the fifth month of military coup and livelihood is getting difficult day by day. The military tried to open schools but most of the parents do not dare to send our children to schools as explosions happen in various schools. Moreover, civilians are now fighting back the military everywhere with whatever weapons they can get. Thousands of people abandon their places for safety. And many people are jobless now since many factories are closed down.
