The reality of the Resurrection is surrounding my soul this morning as I reflect on ministry and as I muse about life in 2021. What each one of us needs is to experience a fresh look at the Risen Christ. Revelation chapter one describes what happened to the Apostle John when he saw the Risen Christ, "...I fell at His feet as dead..." It is interesting to note that John was the beloved disciple who knew Jesus better than anyone else on earth. But when he saw the Risen Christ as He truly is, he fell on his face in fear and worshipped Him.
