One young couple, Eduardo and Nayra Perez, have 95% of their support and are working on visas to go to Thailand. They are planning by God's grace to be there by August of 2021. She and Eduardo are a Godly young couple whom I sure God will use to win many Thai people to our Lord Jesus Christ. Please pray for them.

God has blessed us with good health for the most part. We *are* experiencing issues with our hearing; Bonnie more so than I. I guess hearing aids is our next project, so we are looking into that.

We are so thankful to each of you who support us and pray for us. We thank you for your prayers for the people of Mexico and God's work among them. Please continue to bring us and them before the Lord daily that we will see a great harvest.

Everywhere I look around me, I see an opportunity to be a witness for Christ and to bring glory to His Great Name. I know that it is the same for you. We pray God's blessing on each of you as you work in the place where He has put you.
