One of the shirts has a deep zippered pocket and I needed the zipper fixed. I went into the store and met Han at the counter. He is 78 years old and his wife, Soo-Mi did the alterations. I explained my need and he said his wife could fix it. We got to talking and I told him I needed the shirt for my next trip to Africa. He wanted to know what I did, and I was able to speak to him about the Lord. He was genuinely interested in the Gospel. He asked me to come and pickup the shirt in 2 days. When I returned, I was able to present the Gospel again, and both prayed and asked the Lord to save them. What a privilege it is to share the Gospel!

I am grateful for travel to be open once again to Africa. I have made preparation for our Easter Breakfast in April. I also have made plans for a May trip, a July trip and a trip in August to be with Pastor Samson for the 20th Anniversary of Calvary Independent Baptist Church that we started. I was limited last year due to the COVID-19 restrictions, but this year we will be at full capacity for our travel. I have several services planned at 3 different universities. We have worked around the capacity limits by holding more than one service. I was able to speak to inmates at a prison on my recent trip. We could not hold services inside a building, but I was allowed to speak to inmates outside in smaller groups. The Welfare Officer of the prison asked me about my energy level. He wanted to know how I kept my energy level up at 70. He was worried about COVID-19. I told him I just keep going because the need is great. GOD keeps me running! (Also, proper diet, vitamins, exercise and seeing hundreds saved gets the energy moving!)

Thanks for your prayers for both Linda and me. Linda will turn 70 in April. We are grateful the Lord continues to provide for her needs physically as well her medicines.
