Dear Praying Friends and Faithful Supporters,

Nothing could be more encouraging than to hear the rejoicing of a new convert enjoying the change that comes with genuine Salvation. A young inmate/patient was saved at my facility (CRCC) a little over a month ago. I made a follow-up visit to encourage him a few days later. I gave him some Scripture to read along with a couple of Bible Studies and prayed with him. The next week I saw him in the dayroom as I was preparing to do a service on his unit and asked him how he was doing. His answer was so encouraging I wanted to share it with you. He said, **"So many good things have happened to me since I got saved!"** He was so happy it was infectious! It reminded me of how good I felt when I was saved. He requested prayer that night for his release, (which is not unusual), but then added, **"I have a reason [now] to be out. My child and grandmother need me!"**

Oh Steve!!!!!!!!!! It's FREE!!!! I got this urgent text from Debbie about a month ago. She also forwarded a picture of a "Chorkie" puppy. After years of asking, I couldn't say no to this request. We made arrangements to pick her up after church on a Wednesday night. The husband arrived first and then the wife and puppy. After talking for a little while, she looked at me and said, **"I know you."** Turning to Debbie she said, **"I know you too!"** She explained that she had been in a women's prison and remembered us coming in to do services there. Adding that she had prayed for a Christian husband and God had answered; they seemed to be very content and happy together. I believe those who do well when they get out of prison are the **"quiet ones."** As for me, I have two women in the house now!

As Covid-19 and variants continue to affect our country, many prisons and correctional facilities remain closed to outside preaching ministries such as Rock of Ages. As a result, our annual **South Carolina Blitz** scheduled for the first week in October, was cancelled again this year. Even though other methods such as radio broadcasts have been developed and are being used, in-person preaching and teaching the Gospel is still the most effective. Pray for the opening of the prisons soon.
